### What is Verification?

Verification is the process of confirming the accuracy of the information you provided on your FAFSA. It is a requirement of the federal financial aid process. The Department of Education randomly selects FAFSA records for verification. If your record is selected, you will be notified by email and you will need to provide documentation to verify the information you provided on your FAFSA.

### How will I be notified if my FAFSA record has been selected for verification?

You will be notified by email from the Financial Aid Office. You will also receive a letter from the Financial Aid Office. If you do not receive a letter or email, please contact the Financial Aid Office at (800) 448-7435.

### How are FAFSA records chosen for verification?

- Random selection by the Department of Education
- Institution-provided information

### What documentation will be required in the verification process?

- 2023-2024 Dependent Verification Worksheet
- 2023-2024 Independent Verification Worksheet
- Copy of student 2021 IRS Tax Return Transcript (and spouse if married and filed separately)
- Copy of Parents' 2021 IRS Tax Return Transcript (submit both parents if married and filed separately)
- Statement of Education Purpose & Confirmation of Identity
